Here are the Scholarships we will offer this semester:

## Perfect Peace Scholarship

The Perfect Peace Scholarship awards 500.00 towards the tuition for a Power Student who has a **diagnosed mental illness**. Among other criteria, factors such as school and community involvement, qualities of leadership and in some cases financial need must be demonstrated. Students will need to submit their stories to be considered for this scholarship.

## President's Scholarship

The President's Scholarship awards 100.00 towards the tuition for a student in good standing who has **completed at least one semester**. Among other criteria, factors such as school and community involvement, qualities of leadership and in some cases financial need must be demonstrated. Students will need to submit their stories to be considered for this scholarship.

## In-Ministry Scholarship

The In-Ministry Scholarship awards 500.00 towards the tuition for a Power Student in good standing who has been **volunteering in** worship arts ministry at their local church for one year or more. Among other criteria, factors such as school and community involvement, qualities of leadership and in some cases financial need must be demonstrated. Students will need to submit their stories along with a letter acknowledging service from their local church to be considered for this scholarship.

## Ankle Deep Scholarship

The Ankle Deep Scholarship awards 100.00 towards the tuition for a student who has **little to one years experience in worship arts ministry**. Among other criteria, factors such as school and community involvement, qualities of leadership and in some cases financial need must be demonstrated. Students will need to submit their stories to be considered for this scholarship.
